§16–306. IN EFFECT

Subject to the hearing provisions of § 16–307 of this subtitle, the Comptroller may deny a county license to an applicant, reprimand a county licensee, or suspend or revoke a county license if the applicant or licensee:

- (1) fraudulently or deceptively obtains or attempts to obtain a license for the applicant or licensee or for another person;
- (2) fraudulently or deceptively uses a license;
- (3) violates § 16–308.1 of this subtitle; or
- (4) fails to comply with the Maryland Cigarette Sales Below Cost Act and regulations adopted under it.

§16–306. ** TAKES EFFECT JUNE 1, 2020 PER CHAPTER 12 OF 2019 **

Subject to the hearing provisions of § 16–307 of this subtitle, the Executive Director may deny a county license to an applicant, reprimand a county licensee, or suspend or revoke a county license if the applicant or licensee:

- (1) fraudulently or deceptively obtains or attempts to obtain a license for the applicant or licensee or for another person;
- (2) fraudulently or deceptively uses a license;
- (3) violates § 16–308.1 of this subtitle; or
- (4) fails to comply with the Maryland Cigarette Sales Below Cost Act and regulations adopted under it.
